



# **ASSESSMENT IN WELSH AND IRISH (GAEILGE)**

**Reviewed: 07 November 2023**

## **POLICY**

PIABC's policy is to facilitate the promotion, delivery and assessment of all its qualifications in Welsh and Irish (Gaelige) if there is a demand for this to be available.

Currently there is no demand, but this will be reviewed annually by the PIABC Advisory Board and if there is a need they shall consider making the following available in Welsh and/or Irish (Gaelige):

- Promotional materials
- PIABC policies and procedures
- Scheme documentation,
- Assessment materials
- Certification

The Board will also consider appointing staff with appropriate language skills to conduct assessments, provide administrative support, etc. and will provide training for them.

In making these arrangements, PIABC will ensure that there is sufficient expertise to guarantee the comparability of Welsh and/or Irish (Gaelige) and English language assessments.

If Centres require PIABC materials to be in Welsh/Irish (Gaelige) they should:

1. Contact PIABC as soon as the requirement for alternative language provision becomes known.
2. Provide the following details:
  - The number of candidates likely to require provision in Welsh/Irish (Gaelige)
  - The awards that they are taking
  - When they wish to undertake the assessment
